Frequently Asked Questions

1. Question: How much is each payment?

Answer: YOU determine how much you can pay at each payment, as long as your total registration fee for your household is paid by the final payment deadline date. Make sure you completely fill out Section C and add up the total fees due using the registration fee chart in Section A.

Based on your individual budget, you can determine how you want to split up the payments. However, the initial deposit (\$25.00) for your family is still due on September 30, 2023.

2. Question: Can I pay the total registration fees for my family off early or in a lump sum?

Answer: YES!

3. Question: What about hotels?

Answer: We are currently in negotiations with hotels regarding pricing. We will finalize the family information concerning hotels via email and the family website no later <u>August 30, 2023</u>. At that time, we will update the family. Thank you.

4. Question: Is the deposit per person or the household?

Answer: The \$25.00 dollar deposit is for the household.

5. Question: What is the cancelation/refund policy?

Answer: Cancellations made before the January 31, 2024 deadline will be refunded minus the initial deposit of \$25.00. All initial deposits are non refundable. We hope to see you there!

6. Question: What if I have a child who is 17 now but will be 18 by the time of the reunion. Is the registration fee 30.00 or 100.00? Same question for babies and toddlers?

Answer: Child will need to be 17 at time of reunion. If 18 during the time of reunion, the adult registration fee applies.

7. What happens at a Johnson family reunion?

Answer: At these celebratory events, family history is recounted, traditions are taught, and bonds are strengthened through shared memories and the meeting of known or seldom seen/heard from relatives. We intend to hold our reunions in significant places where a family has historical roots, or where new generations have moved and thrived.

8. Why are family reunions important to our/black families?

Answer: Historically, family reunions date back to the so-called Emancipation, when formerly enslaved people sought out the family they were separated from while enslaved. This tradition would become something that would be a continuous celebration of kinship and resilience that Black families endured.

Frequently Asked Questions, continued

9. What are the five core strengths of African American families?

Answer: The Black family, as described in The Strength of Black Families (Hill, 1972;1997) is the fundamental source of: 1) Strong work orientation 2) Strong religious orientation 3) Strong belief in family 4) Strong achievement orientation 5) Adaptability of family roles.

These strengths are stapled by the typical Black/African values of Communalism and Individualism. The value that traditional African societies place on communalism is expressed in the sharing of a common social life, commitment to the social or common good of the community, appreciation of mutual obligations, caring for others, interdependence, and solidarity...Can we get an **amen!**.

10. How do/can you honor our elders at a family reunion?

Answer: Some ideas for family reunions honoring our elders, for example, may include more elegant-looking dinnerware, gift bags full of memory-inspiring items, or a picture-based family tree display and photo stations inviting the young to add to its branches.

11. Why is family so important in Black culture?

Answer: Black Americans have been defining family through love and connection, as opposed to biology alone, for centuries. Experts say it reflects the sense of community and collective responsibility Black people feel toward each other.

12. What makes a good family reunion?

Answer: Here are a few things you can do to make our family reunion experience successful.

- #1 Consider participating in the event organization and planning.
- #2 Invite/meet a wide range of relatives, known and unknown.
- #3 Participate in a wide range of activities and recognition of attendees.
- #4 Celebrate activities that bring folks together.
- #5 Appreciate lots of time for just hanging out.
- #6 Take photos, recordings, and treasure the memories it brings.
